



Arts Proficiency Seal Pathway:

To qualify for the Arizona State Seal of Arts Proficiency the student will complete:

1. A final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 in each qualifying arts/career and technical education (CTE) course.
2. Four (4) minimum credit requirements in one of the following ways:
 - a. A minimum of four (4) credits in one artistic discipline: (dance, music, theatre, visual arts, or media arts)
OR
 - b. Three (3) credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying creative industries CTE credit or separate artistic discipline.
OR
 - c. Two (2) credits in one artistic discipline, and two (2) credits in a qualifying creative industries CTE course or separate artistic discipline.
3. 80 hours of arts related extracurricular activities
4. A student capstone project
